WHAT WILL PUBLIC PLAY LOOK LIKE AT LAKESHORE YACHT & COUNTRY CLUB IN 2026?

Lakeshore Yacht and Country Club plans to continue offering daily fee golf during the 2026 season. Understandably, we have been receiving many questions pertaining to what this structure means for our members. We are hoping the information below will provide our golf members with a better understanding of what the member experience will look like in 2026.

Public Play Availability

In 2026, public golfers will be able to book tee times for the following days & times:

Mondays - After 12:00 PM
Wednesdays - Before 12:00 PM
Thursdays - Before 12:00 PM
Saturdays & Sundays - After 12:00 PM

Booking Windows

As a full golf member of Lakeshore, you will have your normal 7 day in advance booking window to secure your desired tee time.

Non-Members of Lakeshore will only have a 3 day in advance booking window. This is to ensure that our members have first access to the tee time that they prefer.

Price

We plan to begin the 2026 season with a daily-fee rate of \$75+tax for 18-Holes with a cart. It is very important to note that we will be using a dynamic pricing strategy next season. This means that prices could vary based on the amount of the traffic we are seeing. Example: If a majority of our tee times are being utilized you might see an increase in our rates. If we have a large percentage of our tee times open, lower rates will be used in order to encourage consistent revenue.

All public golf policies and rules are subject to adjustments or changes.



Golf Rules/Guidelines

Dress Code

Proper golf attire is required at all times on the golf course and practice facilities. Dress for men should consist of collared shirts tucked in, golf pants or golf shorts, and hats worn facing forward. Dress for women should consist of golf shirts (collared or designer collarless golf shirt), and shorts, skorts or skirts. T-Shirts, sweat pants, leggings, tank tops, denim, backwards hats/visors, bathing suits, and open toed shoes are not allowed on the golf course or practice facilities. It is the responsibility of the member to ensure their guests abide by the dress code.

Golf Cart Operation

Drivers of golf carts must have a valid New York State drivers license. All golf carts and its drivers must abide by all on course rules including 90 degree rule and/or cart path only restrictions. Carts must stay at least 20 yards away from all greens and tee boxes.

Course Care

We ask that all members and guests fix ball marks, rake bunkers, replace divots. Rakes should be placed inside the bunkers when you have completed raking.

Pace of Play

Acceptable pace of play for an 18-Hole round is 4 hours. Acceptable pace for a 9-Hole round is 2 hours. Players must always allow faster groups to play through.

Groups of 4+

Groups of more than four are allowed in March, April, October, and November. Even in these months groups of more than 4 must be approved and may be denied by the golf staff based on the amount of play that day.

Junior Golfers

Junior golfers are considered to be persons under the age of 18. Junior tee times must be made by calling the golf shop. Online tee time booking is not allowed for a Junior's tee time. We encourage adult supervision of any child under the age of 12. Children are allowed to play on the golf course without supervision as long as they are able to meet certain scoring and/or pace of play requirements that are established by the Golf Professional Staff.

Driving Range

When using the driving range, you must park in the club parking lot and take a golf cart to the range. Parking along Lakeshore Rd while using the range is not allowed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

TEE TIMES: We use the “foreUP” online tee sheet, and each member has a personal username and password that is created upon joining. Tee times can be made 7 days in advance.

- Online tee times can be made through lakeshoreycc.com
 - Click on “book a tee time”
 - Click “members”
 - Enter your username and password
 - Select the date/time you want to play
 - Select the number of players in the group
 - Select the number of holes to be played
 - Select cart or no cart
 - Click “book tee time”
 - You may always call the golf shop to book a tee time

GOLF FEES: Members have the option of charging all fees to their member account or pay by using a credit card or cash in the golf shop. Our golf staff will always assume a guest is being charged to the member’s account unless told otherwise.

18-Hole Cart Fee - \$24

9-Hole Cart Fee - \$12

18-Hole Guest Fee - \$40

9-Hole Guest Fee - \$20

18-Hole Family Guest Fee - \$20

9-Hole Family Guest Fee - \$10

All fees are subject to change. Member guest fee + cart fee will always be lower than our public golf rate with cart.

GHIN HANDICAP SYSTEM: If you wish to compete in member leagues or tournaments, you must have an official handicap. All golf members are billed the \$50 annual GHIN fee (May Bill) in order to receive or renew their GHIN number. This number is used to log into the GHIN system and post scores/view your handicap which is updated daily.

EMAIL COMMUNICATIONS: Lake Shore uses foreUP for email marketing and communication. The golf staff sends out regular golf updates regarding upcoming events, course conditions, and club news.

LOCKER ROOM: Each member may receive a locker with their name on it to be utilized. Our Locker Room Manager or Head Golf Professional may assist you with any questions regarding the locker room. Our Locker Room Manager offers shoe cleaning services where tipping is at the discretion of the member.

GOLF LESSONS: Our Head Golf Professional offers lessons to members of all ages and skill levels. You can book a lesson by email or by calling the golf shop.

JUNIOR GOLF: Introduce your child to golf with Lakeshore Yacht and Country Club's Junior Golf Program. Open to all skill levels, kids receive expert instruction from our Head Golf Professional and his staff in a fun environment. They'll learn the game's fundamentals, improve their skills, and make lifelong friends. (Wednesday mornings during the summer)

GENERAL INFORMATION

BAGROOM/PULLCART STORAGE: The bag room is available for all members and their dependents for the storage of your golf bag at no additional charge. When you need your clubs, tell any bag room employee your name and whether you will be taking a cart, pull cart or walking, and the employee will set up your clubs. After finishing the round, employees will clean your clubs and set them back in your space unless you request to take them with you.

- For members who want to store their pull cart, there is a separate storage area in the garage where we can keep your cart clean and safe. There is a \$110 fee for pull cart storage (May Bill). Check with the golf shop for details and availability.
- Tipping the bag room employees is appreciated but not required. Common gratuity is \$2 - \$5 for each player.
- Custom bag tags are available for purchase through the golf shop.

GOLF COURSE AVAILABILITY

It is highly recommended that you make a tee time before coming out to play, but it is not required. Tee times can be made up to one week in advance. The following shows what a typical week looks like. For daily details, check with the golf shop. All golf shop hours listed are from Memorial Day - Labor Day.

Monday: Golf Shop Hours. 12pm - 7pm

- Many Monday's are reserved for outside outings.
- Regular tee times begin at 12:00pm on Mondays in which we are not hosting an outside outing.

Friday: Golf Shop Hours. 7am - 7pm

- Member Only Play All Day
- Two Fridays per month there is a couples golf event which are 5:30 PM shotgun starts.
- Call the Golf Shop for availability

Tuesday: Golf Shop Hours. 7am - 7pm

- Tee sheet blocked from 8:40-10:00am for the weekly Ladies game.
- Tee sheet blocked on front-9 from 2:00-6:00pm and back-9 from 4:00 - 6:00pm for Men's League.
- All normal play must make the turn to the back 9 by 3:50pm.

Saturday: Golf Shop Hours. 7am - 7pm

- Member Only Play Before 12:00 PM
- Member Skins Game
- *7 day in advance tee times are highly recommended*

Wednesday: Golf Shop Hours. 7am - 7pm

- Member Only Play After 12:00 PM
- Women's 9-hole league begins at 4:00 pm.
- All normal play after 4:00 pm must be on the opposite side of the ladies league.

Sunday: Golf Shop Hours. 7am - 7pm

- Member Only Play Before 12:00 PM
- Member Skins Game
- *7 day in advance tee times are highly recommended*

Thursday: Golf Shop Hours. 7am - 7pm

- Member Only Play After 12:00 PM
- Member Skins Game
- *7 day in advance tee times are highly recommended*

Guest & Junior Restrictions:

- **The same guest is limited to 6 rounds per year at member guest rate**
- Juniors (under the age of 18) must call the golf shop before booking a tee time. Pace of play is very important and tee time availability is at the discretion of the Golf Staff.
